PROJECT SO FAR

The RTB Partnership were granted £3.5m from Lancashire County Council to deliver a new bus station for Rawtenstall, refurbishment of the Old Town Hall and improvement to highways, parking and open spaces this was supported with a further £1.9m funding from the Lancashire Local Enterprise Partnership and £900k from Rossendale Council's Capital projects funding. The RTB Partnership has heavily consulted on plans for the bus station and the wider redevelopment of Rawtenstall over the last few years.

Consultation on future phases on the project will be conducted in March 2017.
